Leaving from Porte Maillot, le Petit Train takes you through the woods to the main entrance to the Jardin d'Acclimatation.



Take the métro
At Les Sablons métro station, take sortie (exit) 2, then walk down rue d'Orléans. The entrance to the Jardin d'Acclimatation is 150 metres away.

Attractions

Wonderful attractions await you at the Jardin d'Acclimatation: take **le Petit Train** (Small Train) drawn by a carbon-free **electric engine** from Porte Maillot to the heart of the Jardin or embark for a ride on the **Enchanted River**. **The Amusement-Ride Village** won't fail to appeal to you: **Chair-O-Planes, the Grasshopper, Alice's Butterflies, the Small Horses, the Automobile Circuit...** Continue the journey: get on the **Dragon's back**, steer **Radio-controlled Boats**, improve your swing at the **Golf School**, go for a ride on **Ponyback** or discover horse riding at the **Riding School**. Throw yourself into **Forest Adventures** then go and enjoy the coolness of **Garden-Beach** and don't leave the Jardin without having tested the mandatory **Trampolines, Zip-lines and Swings**.

• Le Rucher Pédagogique 16 The Educational Apiary

At the entrance to la Petite Ferme (the Small Farm), seven wooden beehives have been arranged to house 240 000 bees. Their activity and honey-making ensure the park's eco-friendliness. 140 kilos of honey have been collected. Food lovers can purchase jars of Jardin d'Acclimatation honey in the Boutique.

• La Maison de Kiso 22 The House of Kiso

An authentic 19th-century Japanese country dwelling from Nagano province has just been reassembled in the Jardin d'Acclimatation. This traditional wooden house was built in 1863, at about the same time that the Jardin d'Acclimatation was opened by Napoléon III.

• Le Potager 18 The Kitchen Garden

Familiarise children and toddlers with plants from everywhere...

• Le Jardin de Séoul 19 The Seoul Garden

Given in 2002 by the City of Seoul to the City of Paris, the Korean garden combines minerality and spirituality. The "Gate to Heaven" opens onto a harmonious space with walls adorned by ochre geometric patterns and onto the granite "purification basin", of Confucian tradition.

• La Grande Volière 20 The Great Aviary

Discover with your children the aviary dating from 1860: budgerigars, pheasants, partridges, parrots...

• Le Belvédère de l'Impératrice 21

Discover this new walk through a hectare of meadows and wooded areas: Scotch firs, black ash trees, birches, poplars...
